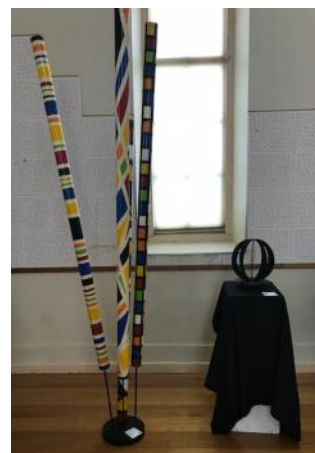

## MYSTERY ANCHOR FOUND NEAR THE POOL.

Recently Steve Robinson (another semi local) and myself went for a scuba dive from the jetty. We regularly do this looking for crabs, other sea life or just exploring. We just head off together in a random direction. On this occasion we choose to head north east and after a while we came across a large anchor. I have done many dives out to this area and never seen this anchor before and neither had Steve!

The anchor is massive and has only one fluke. I believe it was made like this as it is a mooring anchor. It would weigh at least 2 ton and is approximately 3m x 2m in dimension.

As far as I am aware the photos are the first photos ever taken of this anchor in its current location only a couple of hundred metres out from the pool. We believe given it's location the ships would hang off of this waiting for their turn to move in and be loaded or to unload at the jetty.

We will also be contacting the local museum as soon as we can.

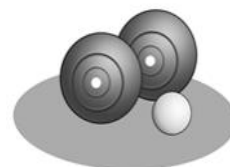

## "NUGGETTS NOSH"



### MINTED LAMB AND YOGHURT KEBABS

#### INGREDIENTS:-

1kg boned leg of lamb, 2 tblspns mint jelly, 4 cloves crushed garlic, 2 tblspns lemon juice, 1 medium red capsicum, 2 tblspns freshly chopped mint, ½ cup low fat natural or Greek yoghurt, soak bamboo skewers in water for 1 hr to prevent burning.

#### METHOD:-

Cut lamb into 3cms pieces, combine mint jelly, garlic and lemon juice in a large bowl, add lamb, refrigerate for at least 3 hours or overnight. Cut capsicum into 3cms pieces, thread lamb and capsicum onto 8 large skewers, sprinkle with a bit of the fresh mint, and add skewers to heated BBQ, cook till browned all over or cooked to desired way, served with jasmine rice and a Greek salad with tzatziki sauce, a cold glass of Rose, or a good lager, Autumn doesn't get any better with friends and family.

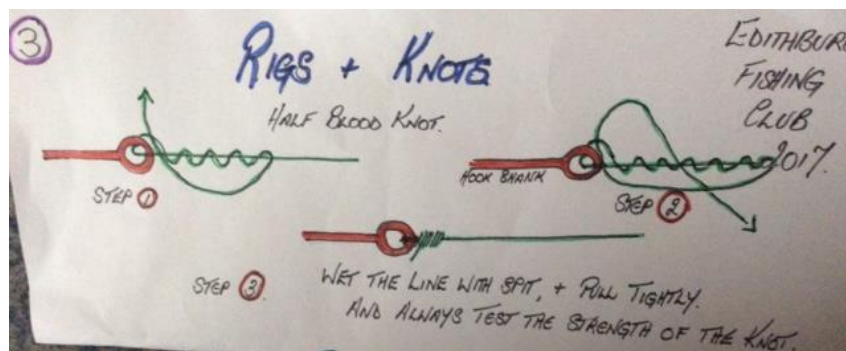
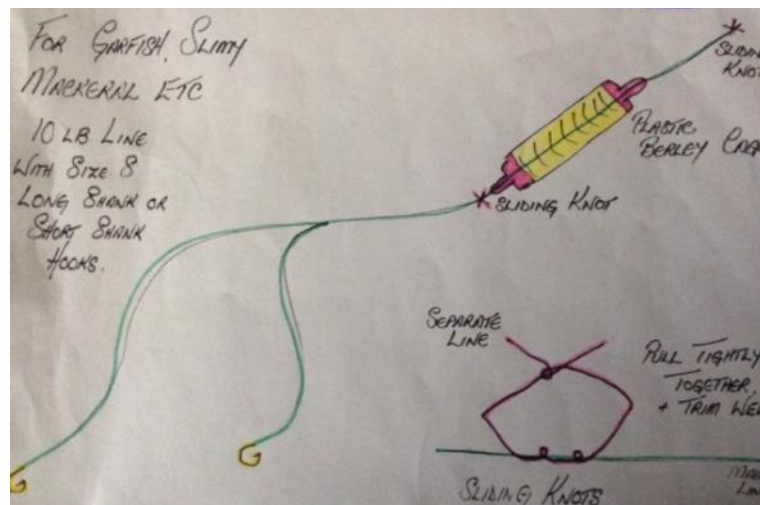
# AWESOME FUN WITH FISHING"



## "RIGS AND KNOTS"

My dad and mum taught me to fish, with the proviso of "bait your own hooks, remove your fish from the hook, make your own rigs, and the classic " you catch them, you clean them ". Which was fine to my brothers and me, but my sister, no way Jose, it wasn't her bag as a young teenager, now she's as good as the rest of us. It's not hard, but does take practice, so here goes

These rigs can be adapted for jetty, land based, and boating by just adding or removing the sinker to make the line stay fairly tight, so you feel every bite, with floats I don't use sinkers, the only real downfall of a float is you have to fish which ever way the tide is going, or you will up underneath the jetty etc. If anyone has ideas or questions, please drop them off at the PO and I will endeavour to answer, or find the answer for you. Tight lines and safe fishing guys.

# Birds of the Heel

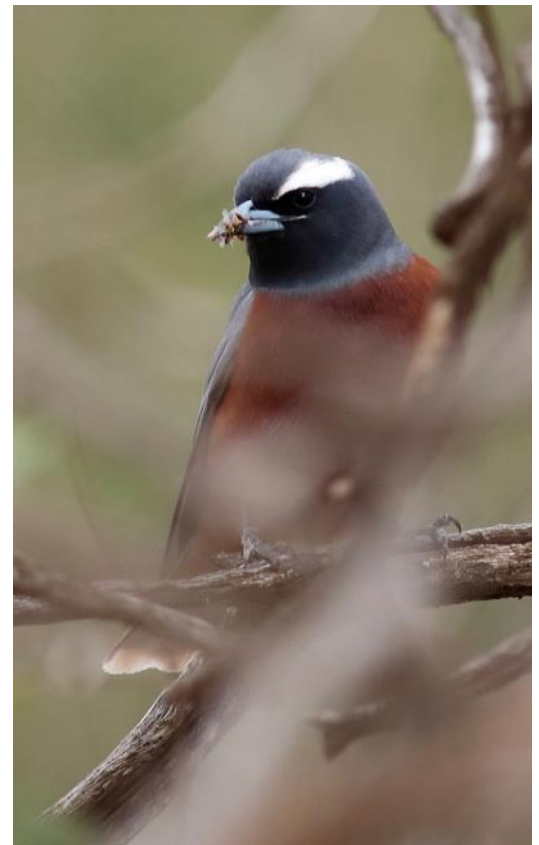

## White-browed Woodswallow

Some days you just get lucky! We were trying to show New Zealand visitors some of our birds. We stopped to admire the extent of the mistletoe in several trees and noticed a Jacky Winter and a pair of Hooded Robins with a juvenile busy feeding in the field behind the tree. I got out of the car and followed the robins and stood close to a tree, birds calls of nestlings made me turn round to find a male White-browed Woodswallow waiting for me to move away which I did after taking its picture. What a strikingly beautiful bird!

The nest was just at the roadside about 1.5 metres off the ground.


