## **"NUGGETTS NOSH"**



### **TANDOORI WHOLE SNAPPER**

#### **INGREDIENTS:-**

1 x whole panfry snapper (or if it's bigger, just double up on the other ingredients), a jar of tandoori paste, 1/4 cup lime juice, 2 tsps salt, cooked rice ready to go, and nice side salad. (coldies in the fridge).

#### **METHOD:-**

Scale and gut the snapper completely, gills as well, then using a very sharp knife, score the flesh both sides 4 times down to the bone, combine lime juice and salt together, and rub in and out, all over. Gets messy here, rub the tandoori paste over each side of the snapper. Leave in the fridge for about 30 mins. Using a BBQ fish rack, pop the fish inside, or onto a rack on top of the BBQ plate, even in a Weber or Q, this works. Over medium heat it should take 10 -15 mins each side to cook through. I think a beer is warranted about now, you deserve that.

Why don't you make a mint yoghurt to go with it, it's truly delicious.

#### **Tipz:-**

Not everyone goes or has access to snapper fishing, don't feel too bad, fresh tommys done this way is exquisite, so is flathead, black bream from the little jetty, kingfish fillets, I wouldn't try whiting, not enough flavour in the fish for my liking, or how about Aussie mullet or salmon. Well worth looking at. Anyway hope you enjoy this recipe.

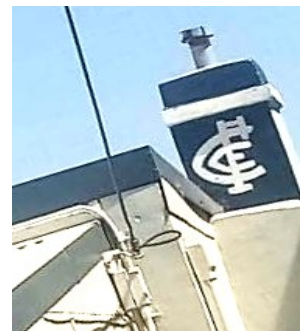

## Birds of the Heel

Jeffrey Robinson

### Bird rescue

In the USA, it has been estimated that 300 million birds are killed annually, flying into windows. These bird deaths are more likely in gardens with bird feeders and water than gardens with no bird attractors. In Adelaide, we have a blind made of shade cloth outside of the window on the family room. The primary purpose of the blind is to keep the sun and heat out in summer. It has a second and important function, before we go out, the blind is pulled down to prevent birds flying into the window and injuring themselves. Usually, it is lorikeets and doves. Recently in Edithburgh, John and Christine Weekly had a Barn Owl fly into their front window, knocking itself out. Fortunately, the Barn Owl recovered after a few minutes and flew off.

This reminded us that we should consider Bird Rescue, if required. Leonie Ware is named in one site and can be contacted on 8834 2130. Veterinary Clinics on the Peninsula may be able to offer advice or help.

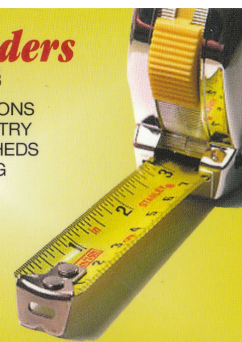
