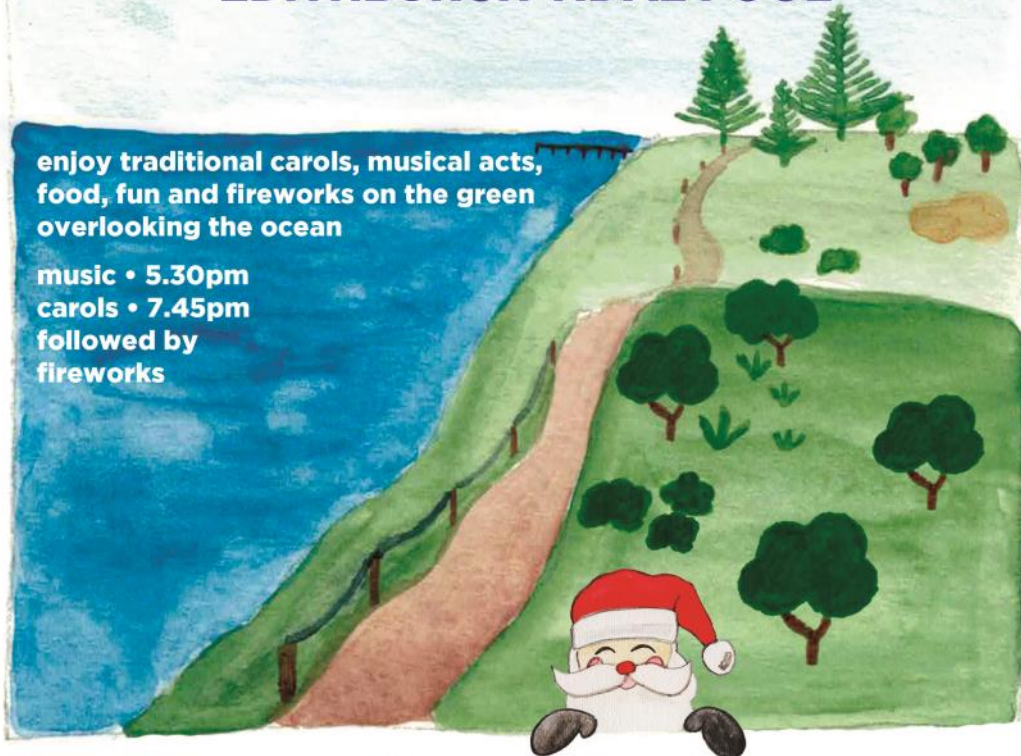

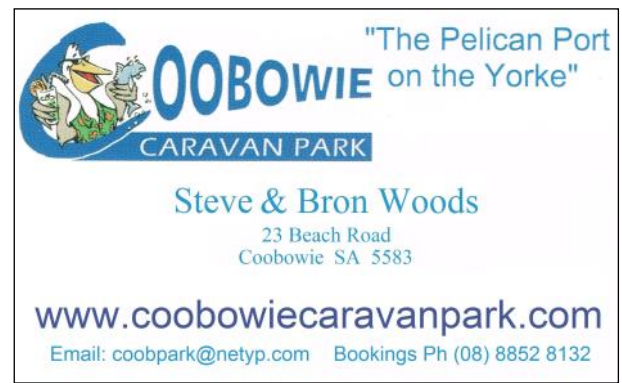
We are open to holding courses on other days or evenings if you have a group who can't make Tuesdays or mornings.

# Birds of the Heel

## Waders and Horsefield's Bronze-Cuckoo

Some stories should tell the truth, so I shall try to do so. In October, I went to the hardware store in Yorketown with my sister-in-law and her husband, both keen bird watchers visiting from England. There is a lake across the Minlaton Road from the hardware store. I noted there are usually few or no birds there and it's not worth looking there, but they protested there were hundreds of waders. Large flocks of Banded Stilts and Red-necked Avocets were close to the shore closest to the road. Avocets are iconic in Britain as the Royal Society for Protection of Birds' logo has an avocet in its centre because it is a rare and threatened species there. Hence, my visitors were thrilled to see many avocets of another species at once.



Next, I turned my attention to a smaller bird on a bush closer to the road. With the poor depth perception at close range due to my monocular vision, I suspected it would be a sparrow. I was completely wrong, as the photograph shows. It is a Horsefield's Bronze-Cuckoo. It can be distinguished from the Shining Bronze Cuckoo by the dark bar through the eye and the bars across the chest that do not extend up the neck in the Horsefield's Bronze Cuckoo, as they do in the Shining Bronze Cuckoo. The Cuckoos lay their egg in smaller bird's nests. However, the Yellow-rumped Thornbill has a strategy that may defeat the Cuckoos, a double nest with a cup on top, but the actual nest is entered from a hole near the bottom. Size ~15cm.

## "NUGGETTS NOSH"



### BRIE and AVOCADO SAVOURY CHEESECAKE

BISCUIT BASE:- 125gm cheese biscuits, finely crushed, 2 tsp water, 60g melted butter.

FILLING:- 125gm Brie cheese, 200gm sour cream, 2 tbsp lemon juice, ¼ cup water, 250gm cream cheese, 1 avocado, 1 tbsp gelatine or equivalent in sheets.

TOPPING:- 1 avocado, 1 tbsp chopped chives, 2 tbsp lemon juice.

METHOD:- BASE, combine biscuits, butter and water and mix well, press evenly over base of a greased 20cm springform cake pan, refrigerate while preparing filling.

FILLING:- Add gelatine to water, stir over a water bath till dissolved ( bowl over pot of boiling water, don't let bowl touch the boiling water though).

Cool slightly when this is done, remove rind from Brie, in a processor, combine Brie, cream cheese, and sour cream till smooth, add avocado and lemon juice, and mix till smooth, gradually add gelatine mixture with processor going, and mix till just combined. Pour filling over base.

TOPPING:- Process avocado, lemon juice and chives till smooth, spread topping over filling and refrigerate over night.

NEXT DAY:- Get your glad rags on, pop white wine in the fridge, make a sexy little salad, lay the table nicely on the porch, verandah, oooh the beach sounds nice, and have a summer brunch with your mates, I can even see me fishing with some of this. C'mon, summer is just round the corner, let's celebrate. It's been a bloody long winter.

## **"NUGGETTS NOSH"**



With spring fast approaching, it's nearly time to dust of the BBQ and the Weber, it's vital you check these before you even think about cooking on it, it's a pretty guess that the mice have had a field day (pardon the pun), running around peeing and crapping on it all winter, so here's a couple of hints to get you started.

- 1:- If you can remove the plates, do so, and check the gas jets for cobwebs, and dirt, an air compressor is good for this, so come on guys, give the girls a hand.
- 2:- Thoroughly wash every inch of the BBQ with boiling hot soapy water, and a stiff brush, then rinse well and dry very carefully, and using some spray oil, grease your plates well, and wipe off excess.
