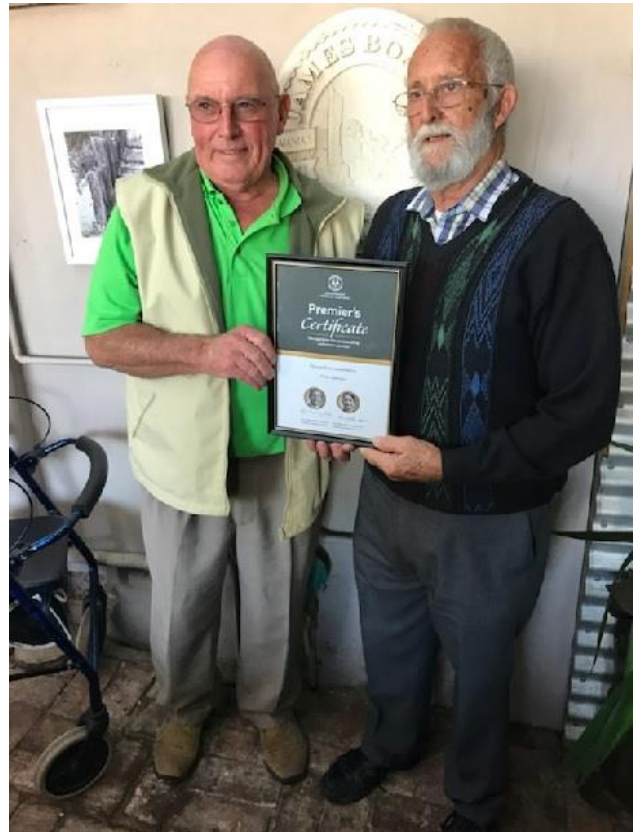
EDITHBURGH PROGRESS ASSOCIATION HOSTS VOLUNTEER MORNING TEA

DRY RUBS FOR MEATS

All sorts of meats deserve a generous rub, (get your mind out of the gutter guys), it adds so much flavour whether you're grilling, oven roasting, smoking, or slow kettle cooking, take your time, and start with the basics. The Yankees have been using rubs since the civil war and have got it down pat, especially BBQ rubs. I'll give you a couple, but don't be frightened to have a crack at a few new flavours of your own.

Its good for more robust meats like hoggett, brisket of beef, goat, chicken drumsticks, chicken thigh meat, even venison could do with a tad of flavoursome dry rubs.

All rubs start with a basic rub mix which consists of

2 tbsps of onion powder, 2 tbsps garlic powder, 1 tspn celery powder, ½ tspn salt, 1 tspn white pepper, and ½ tsp cayenne pepper.

Mix this together well and your under starter orders.

"BURGHS FRIED CHICKEN"



1kg chicken drumsticks, 1 small tub Greek plain yoghurt, dry rub as above, oil for deep frying.

METHOD :- Pour yoghurt into a bowl, along with the chicken, mix together well, and refrigerate at least 3 hrs. Remove chicken and toss really gently in dry rub mix so you don't rub off yoghurt. Heat oil to 165° celsius, and gently deep fry chicken till golden brown. Check to see it's cooked thru to the bone at the thickest end, if not, microwave 1½ minutes on high, wait for chicken to crisp up on standing (believe me, it will), and you have the nearest thing to KFC around these parts partner

FOR HOGGETT, LAMB, EVEN LAMB CHOPS.

Using your basic rub mix, add, 1 tspn of dried mint that has been blitzed to a powder in the electric grinder. Rub the lamb with olive oil sparingly, and roll in the dry rub mix, heat the largest frypan you own, or the BBQ, and brown the meat to golden and finish in the Weber, oven, or whatever you have decided to cook on. The flavours are exceptional when cooked slowly. C'mon folks get these rubs crankin'. I promise you, you won't be disappointed. Go on crack a tinny.

“AWESOME FUN WITH FISHING”



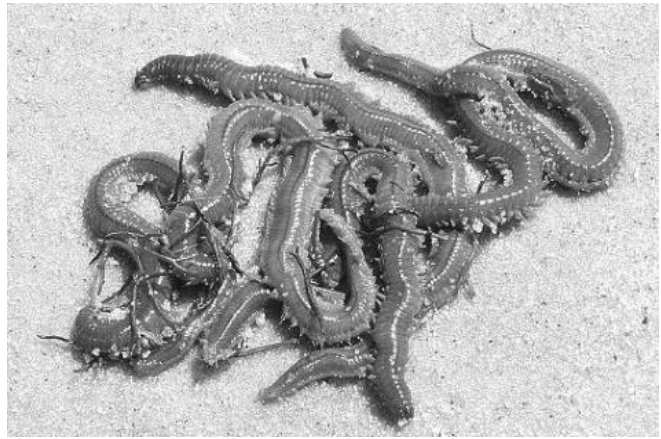
Fishing off our beaches can be really rewarding, for Yellow fin whiting, KG whiting, bream, flathead, salmon trout, plus the fact that, your kids can play safely, the dog can run to its hearts content, and it's relaxing as well. It's a proven medical fact that fisher folk are more inclined not to have high blood pressure. So with that in mind, let's go get some beach worms for bait with the kids, all you need is some wet newspaper, some wet sand in a container, and some smelly fish heads either in your wives old panty hose, (after she's taken them off guys please) or a small lacey onion bag like you buy your onions in. Let's do it.

Drag the bag or pantyhose on a thin rope, along the water line just where the little waves are breaking,

You'll see little holes in the sand and the worms cannot resist rotten fish (they're the garbage eaters of the sea), you have to be quick, and grab the back of their heads, now pull gently or it will break, and it should come out in one load. I have seen them over 2ft long and bigger.

Wet the newspaper and sprinkle it with wet sand, wrap the worms in these, and keep them moist with sea water (tap water will kill them), they should last a good few days. And keep them in the shade while you survey the beaches. On low tide, you should be able to see where the deep water will form, this will be where the fish will enter the gullies as in these photos, take your time and take pictures, it does help.

Plan your fishing day, take plenty of water, a bite to eat (specially if your taking the kids, little buggers are always hungry and get bored easily), but mostly relax, and enjoy your day/night fishing remembering the old adage "A bad day fishing, beats working any day". Ain't that the truth, tight lines and safe fishing.

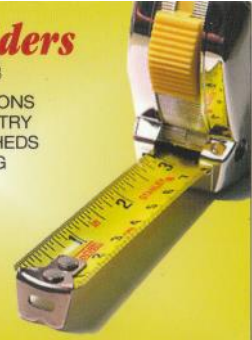
